BÀRBARA FORÉS

Although technically an orange wine, this bottling actually reclaims the ancient 'brisa't' winemaking style which was lost to the enological 'advances' of recent generations in Catalonia's Terra Alta zone. Bàrbara Forés is recognized for leading the way in bringing this heritage back to life.

GRAPE VARIETY: 100% Garnatxa Blanca (White Grenache)

APPELLATION: D.O. Terra Alta

VINEYARDS: A little over one hectare near the town of Gandesa.

SOIL: 'Panal' limestone, formed by sediments brought by the wind.

VITICULTURE: Organic

FRUIT COLLECTION: Harvested by hand

WINEMAKING: A return to the ancient winemaking technique once common in the Terra Alta wine region: white wines with skin contact. In other words, white wine made as if it were a red. Wild yeast fermentation on the skins, pulp and seeds for ten days, then transferred into traditional ceramic 'jarras' to complete fermentation. Aged six months on fine lees in the same vessel.
