The product of 'heroic' steep-slope viticulture on one of Mt. Etna's ancient craters, this volcanic cru is a masterful balancing act between mouthwatering acidity, smooth tannins and meticulously groomed fruit.

GRAPE VARIETIES: Nerello Mascalese; Nerello Capuccio.

APPELLATION: Etna Rosso DOC

VINEYARDS: Bush-trained, pre-phylloxera vines at 800 m.s.l. on a lunar-like, yet richly biodiverse landscape towering over the Mediterranean Sea.

EXPOSURE: Southeast slope of the volcano.

SOIL: Compact black volcanic soil with prevalent sand and pulverized ash content.

VITICULTURE: Organic

PRODUCTION: 3,200 bottles

FRUIT COLLECTION: Harvested by hand

WINEMAKING: Temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel; a minimum of 9 months of aging in French barriques followed by 6 months in the bottle before release.
