



QUARTA GENERAZIONE

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Four generations of Paternoster family winemaking heritage on Basilicata's Mount Vulture led to the genesis of this new legacy-building estate where organically grown Aglianico is the focus. Once referred to as the 'Barolo of the south', Aglianico-based wines are now touted among Italy's greatest native varietals in their own right.

GRAPE VARIETY: Aglianico

APPELLATION: Aglianico del Vulture DOC

VINEYARDS: Three hectares (7.4 acres) situated at 540 m.s.l. (1770 ft) on Mt. Vulture, an extinct volcano, in the historic sub-zone of Macarico between two ancient lava flows, which produce notable diurnal range and a natural defense against vine disease.

EXPOSURE: South

SOIL: Potassium and iron-rich clay over layers of

pyroclastic rock.

VITICULTURE: Organic

PRODUCTION: 20,000 bottles

FRUIT COLLECTION: Harvested by hand

WINEMAKING: Temperature-controlled fermentation followed by 12 months of aging in French oak with

periodic stirring of the lees.
